

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY
BY-LAW NO. 6965

A BY-LAW to amend By-Law No. 1914, being the
"Burnaby Automatic Vending Machine
By-Law 1946"

The Council of The Corporation of the District of
Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY AUTOMATIC VENDING MACHINE BY-LAW 1946, AMENDMENT BY-LAW 1976".
2. Section 8A(1) of By-Law No. 1914, as amended by By-Law No. 6791, is repealed and the following substituted therefor:

"8A (1) Every owner of an automatic vending machine or every person who makes available, or who helps to make available, for use or operation any automatic vending machine shall obtain a licence therefor and shall pay the licence fee set out hereunder;

| (g) For each automatic vending machine for the vending of amusements of any kind operated by the insertion of one cent coins..... | \$ 6.00 |

- (h) For each postage stamp vending machine..... \$ 6.00
- (i) For each coin operated radio receiver..... \$ 6.00"
