

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 7003

A BY-LAW to amend By-Law No. 5174, being the
"Burnaby Refuse By-Law 1967".

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby
ENACTS as follows:

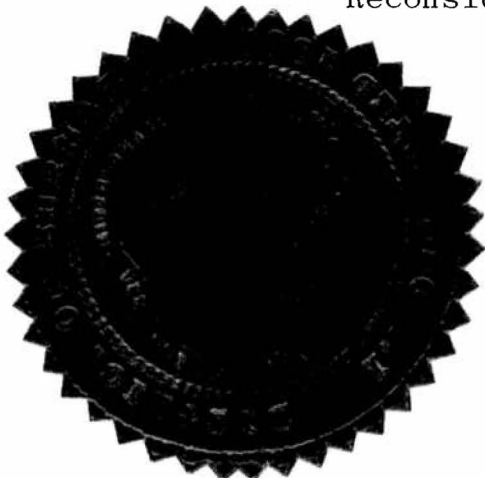
1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY REFUSE BY-LAW 1967,
AMENDMENT BY-LAW 1977."
2. The definition of "Municipal Receptacle" in section 2 of
By-Law No. 5174 is repealed and the following substituted therefor:
""Municipal Receptacle" means any receptacle
provided by the Corporation for any purposes
of this by-law and so constructed that it can
be emptied mechanically by the Corporation's
refuse collection motor vehicles."
3. By-Law No. 5174 is further amended by adding the following
as section 4A:
"4A. The Engineer may supply a municipal receptacle
of a capacity of 3 or 4 cubic yards to any strata
corporation requesting the said receptacle for the
deposit therein of refuse and the strata corporation
shall pay to the Treasurer a monthly rent of \$8.50
in advance for each municipal receptacle provided."


