## THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 7019

A BY-LAW to regulate the parking of motor vehicles within Central Park.

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY CENTRAL PARK PARKING REGULATION BY-LAW".
- 2. In this by-law, unless the context otherwise requires,

- (a) "parking lot" shall mean an area marked, signed, posted, or otherwise designated as such,
- (b) words defined in the Motor Vehicle Act shall have the same meaning when used in this by-law.

The provisions of this by-law shall be in force and effect ral Park (hereinafter called "the park"), being bounded by atterson Avenue, Imperial Street and Boundary Road.

No person shall park a motor vehicle in the park

- (a) unless actually within the park for the sole purpose of enjoyment, pleasure or recreation,
- (b) for the purpose of going to or returning from premises outside the park.
- 5. No person shall park a motor vehicle in the park
  - (a) elsewhere than in a parking lot;
  - (b) in contravention of a sign prohibiting parking or limiting the time during which a motor vehicle may be legally parked.

- Any motor vehicle parked in violation of any of the provisions of this by-law may be removed, detained or impounded by an authorized contractor and the owner of the said motor vehicle shall pay to the said contractor, before the said motor vehicle is returned to his possession, all of the costs of such removal, detention or impoundment which are authorized by this by-law and set out in Schedule "A" annexed hereto.
- 7. (a) Every person who violates sections 4 and 5
  of this by-law shall pay a fine of \$10.00
  provided that if the said fine is paid before
  4:30 o'clock in the afternoon of the next
  business day after the violation, the fine

shall be \$5.00.

(b) In this section, "business day" means any day when the office of the Clerk of the Provincial Court is open for business.
