

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 7051

A BY-LAW to amend By-Law No. 5096, being the "Burnaby Fire Prevention By-Law 1968".

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This by-law may be cited as "BURNABY FIRE PREVENTION BY-LAW 1968, AMENDMENT BY-LAW NO. 2, 1977".

2. Article 4.2.1.3.(2) of By-Law No. 5096 is repealed and the following substituted therefor:

"(2) A person is qualified to be appointed a member of the Department for fire fighting duties who

(a) has successfully completed at least grade 10,

(b) is of good character,

(c) passes such aptitude and other tests as may be required by the Director - Fire Services and the Personnel Officer, and

(d) is medically fit to be a member as certified by a physician designated by the Director - Fire Services."


