THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 7053

A BY-LAW to authorize the expropriation of certain real property for the widening and improvement of Dawson Street.

WHEREAS it is deemed necessary and in the public interest to expropriate the real property hereinafter described for the widening and improvement of Dawson Street.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY EXPROPRIATION BY-LAW NO. 3, 1977".

2. For the widening improvement of Dawson Street, the Council is hereby authorized and empowered without the consent of the owners of the real property but subject to the provisions of Division (4) of Part XII of the Municipal Act, by its servants and agents to enter upon, expropriate, break up, take, enter into possession of and use those certain parcels of real property situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, shown outlined in red on plan with By-law filed No_52808_____, more particularly known and described as follows:

- (a) That portion of Lot 1, Block 10 of the East ½ of
 District Lot 119, Group 1, Plan 2855, New Westminster
 District, containing by admeasurement 12.5 square feet;
- (b) That portion of Lot 10, Block 8 of the East $\frac{1}{2}$ of District Lot 119, Group 1, Plan 2855, New Westminster District, containing by admeasurement 12.5 square feet;

3. The Council is further authorized and empowered by its servants and agents to enter upon any real property which may be injuriously affected by the exercise of the powers in this by-law granted for the purpose of executing any works of construction, maintenance and repair in mitigation of injury done or apprehended or in reduction of compensation. 4. This By-law shall, before coming into effect, be published once in the B.C. Gazette and in a newspaper published or circulating in the Municipality of Burnaby and a certified copy of the by-law shall be filed in the Land Registry Office at New Westminster, in the Province of Btitish Columbia.
