

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 7068

A BY-LAW to dispose of a certain portion of highway in exchange for other land.

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 509 of the Municipal Act the Council may by by-law dispose of any portion of a highway in exchange for such lands as may be necessary for the purpose of improving, widening, straightening, relocating or diverting a highway.

AND WHEREAS all deeds executed under this section have effect as a Crown grant, free of all rights-of-way, and all lands taken in exchange for any portion of a highway under this section are public highways, and the title thereto is vested in the Crown.

AND WHEREAS the Council, before adopting this by-law, has caused the required statutory public notice of its intention to be given by advertisement.

AND WHEREAS the Council deems it expedient and in the public interest to stop up and close to traffic that portion of highway more particularly hereinafter described for the purpose of relocating and diverting a highway.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY HIGHWAY EXCHANGE BY-LAW NO. 3, 1977".
2. The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is hereby authorized and empowered to stop up and close to traffic ALL AND SINGULAR that certain parcel or tract of land and premises, situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, being described as that portion of District Lot 79, Group 1, New Westminster District, Plan 26541 shown outlined in green colour on plan prepared by Bryan S. Berting, B.C.L.S., sworn the 18th day of November, 1977 and containing by admeasurement 0.556 acres, more or less, a copy of which is annexed hereto.

3. The Council is further authorized and empowered to grant and convey that certain parcel or tract of land and premises more particularly described in Section 2 hereof by a good and sufficient deed in fee simple unto the registered owner of that certain parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, more particularly described as that portion of Lot 1 and of Lot 2, Block 12, Plan 23459, and of Lot 6, Block 13, Plan 2298, all of District Lot 79, Group 1, New Westminster District, shown outlined in red colour on the aforesaid plan prepared by Bryan S. Berting, B.C.L.S., and containing by admeasurement 0.639 acres, more or less, a copy of which is annexed hereto.

4. The said deed in fee simple shall be executed on behalf of the Municipality by the Mayor and Clerk and shall have effect as a Crown grant, free of all rights-of-way, and the lands hereinbefore described taken in exchange shall be a public highway and the title thereto shall be vested in the Crown.
