THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY BY-LAW NO. 7103

A BY-LAW to amend By-Law No. 4742, being the "Burnaby Zoning By-Law 1965".

WHEREAS it is deemed desirable and expedient to amend "Burnaby Zoning By-Law 1965", as hereinafter set forth.

AND WHEREAS Council has held a public hearing thereon after duly giving notice of the time and place of such hearing.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY ZONING BY-LAW 1965, AMENDMENT BY-LAW NO.57, 1977".
- 2. Section 3 of By-Law No. 4742 is amended by adding the following definition:

""LUNCH BAR" means an eating establishment where cold lunches packed in containers, cold wrapped sandwiches, beverages or foods obtained from coin operated compartments are sold to the public for consumption either on or off the premises."

3. Section 401.1(1) of By-Law No. 4742 is amended by adding the following as clause (q):

"(q) Lunch Bar."
