

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 7124

A BY-LAW to Stop Up and Close to Traffic
Certain Portions of Road.

WHEREAS those portions of road shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed hereto dedicated by Plans 3035, 22406, 25826 and 26444 are no longer required for road purposes.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY ROAD CLOSING BY-LAW NO. 5, 1977".
2. Those portions of road situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, and being those portions of District Lot 29, Group 1, New Westminster District, Plans 3035, 22406, 25826 and 26444 shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed hereto prepared by Bryan S. Berting, B.C.L.S., sworn the 19th day of August, 1977, are hereby stopped up and closed to traffic.
3. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized and empowered to petition the Minister of Municipal Affairs and Housing to abandon the said portions of road more particularly described in section 2 hereof and vest title thereto in the name of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby.
4. By-Law No. 7091, being the "Burnaby Road Closing By-Law No. 5, 1977", is hereby repealed.
