

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 7127

A BY-LAW to provide for the holding of an advanced poll for the 1977 municipal elections, including submissions to the electors.

WHEREAS section 54 of the Municipal Act provides that the Council may by by-law provide for the holding of an advanced poll at all elections, including submissions to the electors.

AND WHEREAS polling-day for the 1977 municipal elections is November 19th as provided in section 53 of the Municipal Act.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY ADVANCED POLL BY-LAW 1977".
2. The Returning Officer shall open and keep open at the Municipal Hall an advanced poll for the 1977 municipal elections, including submissions to the electors, on each of the three days immediately preceding polling-day, namely November 16, 17 and 18, 1977 between the hours of 8:30 o'clock in the forenoon and 8:00 o'clock in the afternoon.
3. By-Law No. 6924, being the "Burnaby Advanced Poll By-Law 1976", is repealed.
