THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY BY-LAW NO. 7133

A BY-LAW to Stop Up and Close to Traffic a Portion of Road.

WHEREAS that portion of road shown outlined in red on the plan annexed hereto was established as road by plan deposited in the Land Registry Office at the City of New Westminster, Province of British Columbia, and numbered 40316.

AND WHEREAS the said portion of road is no longer required for road purposes.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY ROAD CLOSING BY-LAW NO. 8, 1977".
- 2. That portion of road situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, and being described as that portion of District Lots 8 and 56, Group 1, New Westminster District, Plan 40316, shown outlined in red on the plan annexed hereto prepared by Bryan S. Berting, B.C.L.S., sworn the 19th day of October, 1977, is hereby stopped up and closed to traffic.
- 3. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized and empowered to petition the Minister of Municipal Affairs and Housing to abandon the said portion of road and vest title thereto in the name of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby.
