THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 7153

A BY-LAW to amend By-Law No. 3065, being the "Burnaby Club Regulation By-Law 1950".

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY CLUB REGULATION BY-LAW 1950, AMENDMENT BY-LAW 1977".
- 2. Section 2 of By-Law No. 3065 is repealed and the following substituted therefor:
 - "2. No club shall operate or carry on business unless it holds a valid and subsisting licence from the Municipality. The fee for a first licence shall be \$260.00 and the fee for a renewal licence shall be \$165.00."
- 3. Section 4 of By-Law No. 3065 is struck out and the following substituted therefor:
 - "4. Every club carrying on business within the Municipality shall appoint a manager who shall, before entering upon his duties, be in possession of a valid and subsisting licence. For a first licence the fee shall be \$85.00 and for a renewal licence the fee shall be \$40.00."
- 4. Section 5 of By-Law No. 3065 is repealed and the following substituted therefor:
 - "5. All licences shall be issued for a period of one year and no proportionate fee reduction shall be made on account of commencing or ceasing to do business at any particular time."
