

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 7163

A BY-LAW to expropriate certain real property  
for pleasure, recreation and community  
uses of the public.

WHEREAS Council may by by-law acquire by purchase,  
lease, or otherwise, accept and hold any real or personal property  
within the municipality for pleasure, recreation, or community uses  
of the public.

AND WHEREAS Council may expropriate subject to  
Division (4) of Part XII of the Municipal Act any real property for  
the aforesaid purposes.

AND WHEREAS Council deems it desirable and in the  
public interest to expropriate the real property more particularly  
hereinafter described for pleasure, recreation, and community uses  
of the public.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the  
District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY EXPROPRIATION  
BY-LAW NO. 7, 1977".
2. The Council does hereby expropriate in fee simple for  
pleasure, recreation, and community uses of the public that parcel  
of real property situate, lying and being in the Municipality of  
Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, more particularly  
known and described as Lots 14 and 15, Block 6, Lot 30, Group 1,  
Plan 3036, New Westminster District
3. This by-law shall, before coming into effect, be  
published once in the B. C. Gazette and in a newspaper published  
or circulating in the Municipality of Burnaby and a certified copy

of the by-law shall be filed in the Land Registry Office at the City of New Westminster, in the Province of British Columbia.
