

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 7165

A BY-LAW to authorize the acquisition of certain real property for park purposes.

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY PARK ACQUISITION BY-LAW 1978".
2. The Council is hereby authorized and empowered to acquire from the registered owners thereof by a good and sufficient deed in fee simple for park purposes those lands and premises situate lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, more particularly known and described as that 0.809 acre portion of Lot 55, District Lot 162, Group 1, Plan _____, New Westminster District, shown outlined in red on plan prepared by Hans J. Troelsen, B.C.L.S., sworn the 24th day of November, 1977, a copy of which is hereunto annexed.

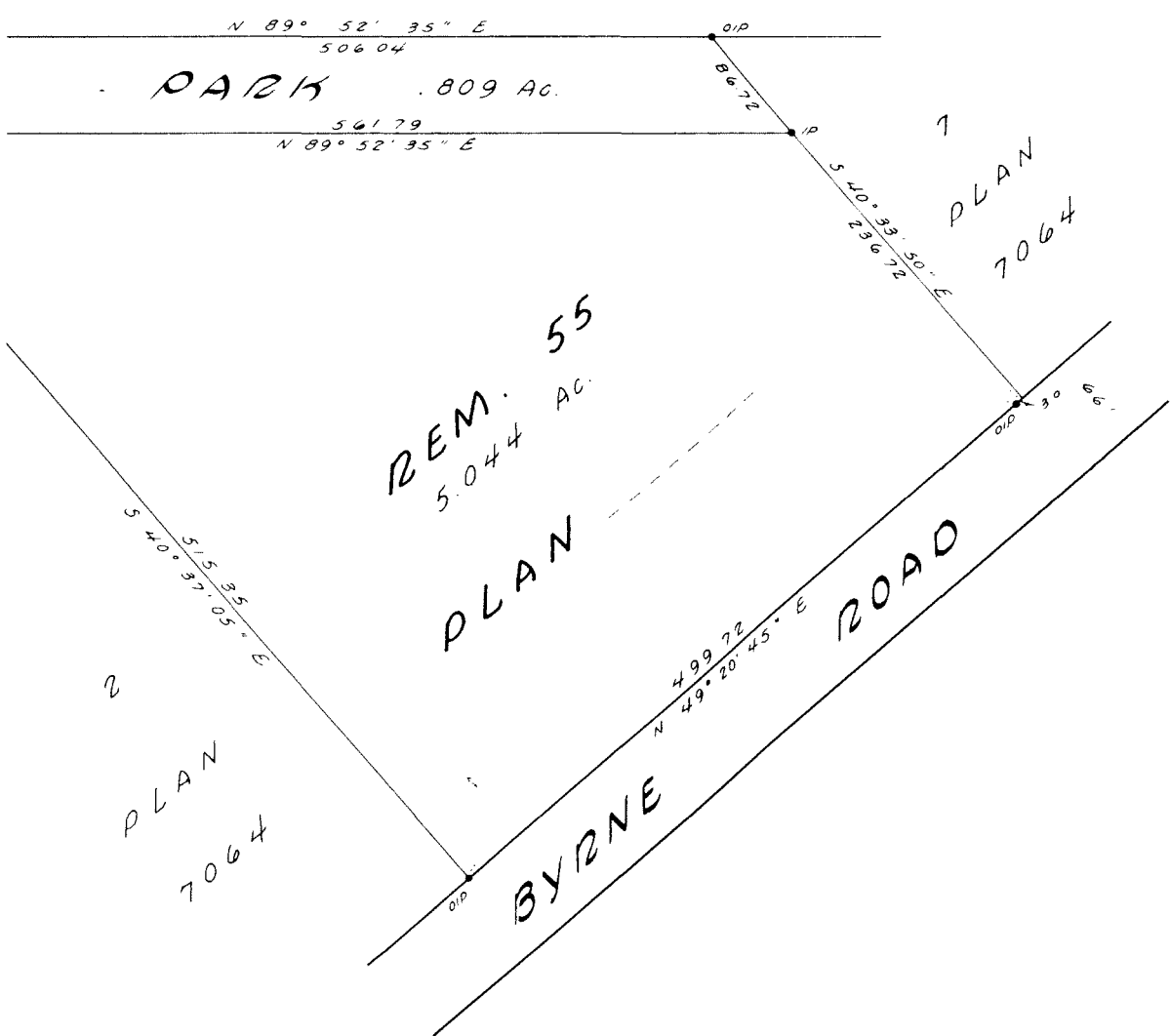
