A BY-LAW to Stop Up and Close to Traffic a Portion of Road.

WHEREAS that portion of road shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed hereto was established as road by By-Law No. 3476 (By-Law Filing 38453).

AND WHEREAS the said portion of road is no longer required for road purposes.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

 This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY ROAD CLOSING BY-LAW NO. 2, 1978".

That portion of road situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, and being described as that portion of road in District Lot 125, Group 1, dedicated by Road Acquisition and Dedication By-Law No. 3476 (By-Law Filing 38453) New Westminster District, shown outlined in red on the plan annexed hereto prepared by Bryan S. Berting, B.C.L.S., certified correct the 14th day of December, 1977 and containing 1.794 Acres, is hereby stopped up and closed to traffic.
