BY-LAW NO. 7176

## A BY-LAW to Stop Up and Close to Traffic certain Portions of Road.

WHEREAS those portions of road shown outlined in red on the plan annexed hereto dedicated by Plans 1397, 1775 and By-Law Plan 41869 are no longer required for road purposes.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY ROAD CLOSING BY-LAW NO. 3, 1978".

2. Those portions of road situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, more particularly hereinafter described and shown outlined in red on the plan annexed hereto prepared by Bryan S. Berting, B.C.L.S., certified correct the 1st day of November, 1977, are hereby stopped up and closed to traffic:

- (a) That portion of District Lot 70, Group 1, New Westminster District, Plan 1397, containing by admeasurement 1.407 acres;
- (b) That portion of District Lot 70, Group 1, New Westminster District, Plan 1775, containing by admeasurement 4.400 acres;
- (c) That portion of lane being Parcel 'A' (By-Law Plan 41869) of Lot 9 of Block 7 of the South Part of the East Half of the East Half of District Lot 70, Group 1, Plan 1775, New Westminster District, containing by admeasurement 0.045 acres.

3. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized and empowered to petition the Minister of Municipal Affairs and Housing to abandon the said portion of road more particularly described in Section 2 hereof and vest title thereto in the name of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby.
