A BY-LAW to Stop Up and Close to Traffic a Portion of Road.

WHEREAS that portion of road shown outlined in red on the plan annexed hereto dedicated by Plan 1733 is no longer required for road purposes.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This by-law may be cited as "BURNABY ROAD CLOSING BY-LAW NO. 4, 1978".
- 2. That portion of road situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, and being that portion of Block 22, District Lot 32, Group 1, New Westminster District, shown outlined in red on the plan annexed hereto prepared by John D. Nash, B.C.L.S., and containing by admeasurement 2,674 square feet, more or less, is hereby stopped up and closed to traffic.
- 3. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized and empowered to petition the Minister of Municipal Affairs and Housing to abandon the said portion of road more particularly described in Section 2 hereof and vest title thereto in the name of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby.


