THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY BY-LAW NO. 7183

A BY-LAW to acquire and dedicate certain lands for highway purposes.

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-Law may be cited as "BURNABY ROAD ACQUISITION AND DEDICATION BY-LAW NO. 1, 1978".

2. The Council is hereby authorized and empowered to acquire from the registered owner thereof by a good and sufficient deed in fee simple, free and clear of all encumbrances, for highway purposes, in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other good and valuable consideration, those certain parcels or tracts of land situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, more particularly known and described as

(a) that portion of Lot 24, District Lot 73, Group 1, Plan 42037, New Westminster District, shown outlined in red on the plan annexed hereto prepared by Bryan S. Berting, B.C.L.S., sworn the 6th day of February, 1978, and containing by admeasurement 4.6 m², more or less, and

(b) that portion of Lot 158, District Lot 74, Group 1, Plan 52787, New Westminster District, shown outlined in red on the aforesaid plan, and containing by admeasurement 4.6 m^2 , more or less.

3. Upon registration of the said deeds in fee simple in the Land Registry Office at the City of New Westminster, Province of British Columbia, the lands therein described shall be established as a public highway.
