

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 7217

A BY-LAW to amend By-Law No. 6191, being the
"Burnaby Dog Tax and Pound and Animal
Regulation By-Law 1972".

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby
ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY DOG TAX AND POUND
AND ANIMAL REGULATION BY-LAW 1972, AMENDMENT BY-LAW NO. 1, 1978".

2. Section 3 of By-Law No. 6191, as enacted by By-Law No.
7054, is repealed and the following substituted therefor:

"3. (1) Every person within the Municipality who owns a dog
shall

(a) have a valid and subsisting licence for
the said dog;

(b) procure the said licence upon application
in writing to the Licence Inspector of the
Corporation upon the form provided and upon
paying the prescribed licence fee, namely:

- (i) for each unneutered male dog.... \$ 21.00
- (ii) for each neutered male dog..... \$ 6.00
- (iii) for each unspayed female dog.... \$ 21.00
- (iv) for each spayed female dog..... \$ 6.00

(2) Every person applying for a licence for a neutered
male dog or spayed female dog shall, in order to obtain the said
licence, present a certificate in writing from a licenced and qualified
veterinarian certifying that the said dog is neutered or spayed.

(3) Upon presenting a certificate in writing from a licenced and qualified veterinarian certifying that a dog is too old or physically unable to undergo the necessary surgery, an applicant for a licence shall be entitled to obtain a licence for the said dog upon payment of the required fee for a spayed or neutered dog notwithstanding that the said dog is not spayed or neutered as the case may be.

(4) Every person who has obtained a licence for an unneutered male dog or unspayed female dog and paid therefor the fee specified herein shall, before the expiration of the licence period and within six months of the purchase of the licence, upon presenting a certificate in writing from a licenced and qualified veterinarian certifying that the dog for which the said licence was issued has been neutered or spayed, be entitled to a refund of \$15.00.

(5) The said licence when issued shall be for the current calendar year."

Read a third time this 15th day of May, 1978.
