That portion of road situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, and being that portion of road in District Lot 11, Group 1, New Westminster District, dedicated by Road Exchange By-Law No. 4375 (By-Law Filing 61468) shown outlined in red on plan attached hereto prepared by Bryan S. Berting, B.C.L.S., and containing by admeasurement 0.172 acres, certified correct the 29th day of September, 1977, is hereby stopped up and closed to traffic.
- 3. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized and empowered to petition the Minister of Municipal Affairs and Housing to abandon the said portion of road more particularly described in Section 2 hereof and vest title thereto in the name of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby.
