## THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 7238

A BY-LAW to amend By-Law No. 5174, being the "Burnaby Refuse By-Law 1967"

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY REFUSE BY-LAW 1967, AMENDMENT BY-LAW NO. 1, 1978".
- 2. By-Law No. 5174 is amended by adding the following as section 5A:
  - "5A. The Engineer may supply a municipal receptacle of a capacity of 3 or 4 cubic yards to the owner or occupier of any commercial or industrial premises requesting the said receptacle for the deposit therein of refuse and the said owner or occupier shall pay to the Treasurer a monthly rent in advance for each municipal receptacle provided of \$10.00 (with no castors) and \$11.00 (with castors)."
  - 3. Schedule "B" of By-Law No. 5174, as enacted by By-Law No. 7155, is repealed and the following substituted therefor:

## "SCHEDULE 'B'

One collection a week:

(a) for each commercial and industrial receptacle collected

\$ .70

(b) for each municipal receptable collected from commercial or industrial premises

\$ 8.00 (no castors)

\$ 8.50 (with castors)

- (c) for every cubic yard, or part thereof as estimated by the collector of refuse, landscape refuse, construction or demolition refuse (in special receptacles or not in receptacles) \$ 3.35
- (d) for every container pickup requested by the strata title owner over and above the normal schedule

\$10.00 for each container of 3 or 4 cubic yard capacity."
