THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY BY-LAW NO. 7250

A BY-LAW to Stop Up and Close to Traffic Portions of Road

WHEREAS those portions of road shown outlined in red on the plan annexed hereto dedicated by Plan 3234 and Plan 1256 are no longer required for road purposes.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY ROAD CLOSING BY-LAW NO. 7, 1978".
- Those portions of road situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, and being part of District Lot 135, Plan 3234 and of District Lot 138, Plan 1256, Group 1, New Westminster District, shown outlined in red on plan attached hereto prepared by Gordon E. McLaren, B.C.L.S., sworn the 3rd day of August, 1978 and containing by admeasurement 714 m^2 and 872 m^2 respectively, are hereby stopped up and closed to traffic.
- 3. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized and empowered to petition the Minister of Municipal Affairs and Housing to abandon the said portion of road more particularly described in Section 2 hereof and vest title thereto in the name of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby.
