BY-LAW NO. 7256

A BY-LAW to establish a reserve fund pursuant  
to section 301 of the Municipal Act.

WHEREAS Council may by by-law establish a reserve fund for  
the purposes set out in section 301 of the Municipal Act.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District  
of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:


1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY RESERVE FUND BY-LAW  
1978".
2. The Council does hereby establish a reserve fund for
  - (a) expenditures for or in respect of capital projects  
and any land, machinery, or equipment necessary  
therefor, including the extension or renewal of  
existing capital works;
  - (b) the purchase of machinery and equipment for the  
maintenance of municipal property and for the  
protection of persons and property;
3. Money from current revenue or, to the extent to which it is  
available, from general revenue fund surplus, or as otherwise provided in the  
Municipal Act, may from time to time be paid into the said fund.
