

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 7286

A BY-LAW to exempt from taxation certain
lands and improvements.

WHEREAS prior to the 30th day of November in any year Council may by by-law, adopted by an affirmative vote of at least two-thirds of all the members thereof, exempt from taxation imposed under clauses (a), (b) and (c) of subsection (1) of section 206 of the Municipal Act, lands and improvements not being operated for profit or gain and owned by a charitable or philanthropic organization supported in whole or in part by public funds and used exclusively for the relief of the poor, the aged, the infirm, or the disabled, or as a home for the care of children.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY TAXATION EXEMPTION BY-LAW NO. 12, 1978".
2. The Council does hereby exempt from taxation imposed under clauses (a), (b) and (c) of subsection (1) of section 206 of the Municipal Act for the year 1979 those lands and premises owned by the Boys' Clubs of Vancouver, B.C. situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, more particularly known and described as Lot 103, District Lot 127, Group 1, Plan 45265, New Westminster District.
