

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 7295

A BY-LAW to provide for an annual indemnity
for the Mayor and Aldermen.

WHEREAS the Council may by by-law provide for the paying out
of the annual revenue an annual indemnity to the Mayor and to the Aldermen, and the
indemnity of the Mayor may be greater than for the other members of Council.

AND WHEREAS such by-law may provide that a portion of the
remuneration to be made to the Mayor or to an Alderman shall be paid as an allowance
for expenses incidental to the discharge of the duties of his office.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of
Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY COUNCIL INDEMNITY BY-LAW
1979".
2. There shall be paid to the Mayor out of the annual revenue an
annual indemnity of \$35,000.00 and one-third of the said annual indemnity shall be
paid as an allowance for expenses incidental to the discharge of the duties of his
office.
3. There shall be paid to each Alderman out of the annual revenue
an annual indemnity of \$9,000.00 and one-third of the said annual indemnity shall be
paid as an allowance for expenses incidental to the discharge of the duties of his
office.
4. By-Law No. 7134 is repealed.
5. This By-law shall come into force and effect on the 1st day of
January, 1979.
