THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 7300

A BY-LAW to amend By-Law No. 3065, being the "Burnaby Club Regulation By-Law 1950".

The Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY CLUB REGULATION BY-LAW 1950, AMENDMENT BY-LAW 1978".
- Section 2 of By-Law No. 3065, as enacted by By-law No. 7153, is repealed and the following substituted therefor:
 - ''2. No club shall operate or carry on business unless it holds a valid and subsisting licence from the Municipality. The fee for a first licence shall be \$300.00 and the fee for a renewal licence shall be \$175.00".
- 3. Section 4 of By-Law No. 3065, as enacted by By-law No. 7153, is repealed and the following substituted therefor:
 - "4. Every club carrying on business within the Municipality shall appoint a manager who shall, before entering upon his duties, be in possession of a valid and sibsisting licence. For a first licence the fee shall be \$90.00 and for a renewal licence the fee shall be \$45.00."
