## THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY BY-LAW NO. 7310

A BY-LAW to amend By-Law No. 6333, being the "Burnaby Building By-Law 1973".

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY BUILDING BY-LAW 1973, AMENDMENT BY-LAW NO. 1, 1979".
- 2. Paragraph (c) of subsection (2) of section 4 of By-Law No. 6333, as enacted by By-Law No. 7177, is repealed and the following substituted therefor:
- "(2) The Building Inspector shall issue a construction permit when
  - (c) the applicant has deposited with the

    Corporation a cash bond in the sum of
    \$200.00 to guarantee payment to the

    Corporation for all damage to municipal

    streets, works or property occasioned in

    any way by the construction described in

    the permit, including the removal of all

    debris from municipal streets but the

    applicant shall be liable notwithstanding

    for the full amount of all damage herein

    described.

Provided that the said cash bond shall not be required for internal renovations or external renovations contained within the existing foundations of any single-family or two-family dwelling."
