BY-LAW NO. 7322

A BY-LAW to Stop Up and Close to Traffic  
a Portion of Road

WHEREAS that portion of road shown outlined in red on the plan annexed hereto dedicated by Plan 450 is no longer required for road purposes.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-Law may be cited as "BURNABY ROAD CLOSING BY-LAW NO. 2, 1979".
2. That portion of road situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, within Block 7, District Lot 162, Group 1, Plan 450, New Westminster District, shown outlined in red on plan attached hereto prepared by Bryan S. Berting, B.C.L.S., certified correct the 30th day of January, 1979 and containing by admeasurement 1,315 m<sup>2</sup>, is hereby stopped up and closed to traffic.
3. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized and empowered to petition the Minister of Municipal Affairs to abandon the said portion of road more particularly described in Section 2 hereof and vest title thereto in the name of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby.
