BY-LAW NO. 7338

A BY-LAW to Stop Up and Close to Traffic Portions of Road

WHEREAS those portions of road shown outlined in red on the plan annexed hereto dedicated by Plan 1256 are no longer required for road purposes.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY ROAD CLOSING BY-LAW NO. 3, 1979".
- Those portions of road situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, and being those portions of road in District Lot 138, Group 1, New Westminster District, dedicated by Plan 1256, shown outlined in red on plan attached hereto prepared by Bryan S. Berting, B.C.L.S., certified correct the 14th day of March, 1979 and containing by admeasurement 0.1013 ha., 0.1028 ha. and 0.1515 ha., are hereby stopped up and closed to traffic.
- 3. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized and empowered to petition the Minister of Municipal Affairs to abandon the said portions of road more particularly described in Section 2 hereof and vest title thereto in the name of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby.
