

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 7365

A BY-LAW to amend By-Law No. 6163, being the  
"Burnaby Sign By-Law 1972"

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby  
ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY SIGN BY-LAW 1972,  
AMENDMENT BY-LAW NO. 1, 1979".
2. Clause (9) of Schedule No. 1 of By-Law No. 6163 is repealed  
and the following substituted therefor:

"(9) Temporary signs pertaining to campaigns, drives or  
events of political, civic, philanthropic, educational  
or religious organizations. Provided that if an  
applicant shall obtain the consent of Council and  
shall agree in writing to remove such signs within  
three days after the campaign, drive or event has  
concluded, such signs may be erected upon public  
property in the possession or control of the  
Municipality."
