

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 7407

A BY-LAW to dedicate certain real property owned by the Municipality for park, pleasure, recreation, or community uses of the public.

WHEREAS the Council of a city, town, district or village municipality may, with the assent of the electors, by by-law dedicate for public purposes any real property owned by the Municipality.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY DEER LAKE PARK DEDICATION BY-LAW 1979".
2. The Council does hereby dedicate for park, pleasure, recreation, or community uses of the public that real property owned by the Municipality, more particularly described as Lot 264, District Lots 83, 84 and 93, Group 1, Plan 56859, New Westminster District.


