## THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 7408

A BY-LAW to expropriate certain real property for highway purposes.

WHEREAS Council may by by-law establish, widen, alter, relocate, or divert a highway or any portion of a highway.

AND WHEREAS for such purpose Council may by by-law enter upon, expropriate, break up, take or enter into possession of and use any real property in any way necessary or convenient therefor without the consent of the owners of the real property but subject to the provisions of Division (4) of Part XII of the Municipal Act.

AND WHEREAS the real property hereinafter described is required for highway purposes.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY EXPROPRIATION BY-LAW NO. 2, 1979".
- 2. Council does hereby expropriate for highway purposes, without the consent of the owners thereof but subject to the provisions of Division (4) of Part XII of the Municipal Act that parcel of real property situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, more particularly known and described as
  - (a) Lot "C" of Lot 3 and of Lot "B" of Lot 2, Block 1, District Lot 77, Group 1, Plan 13194, New Westminster District;
  - (b) Lot "D" of Lot 3 and of Lot "B" of Lot 2, Block 1, District Lot 77, Group 1, Plan 13194, New Westminster District.

- 3. This By-law shall before coming into effect be published once in the B. C. Gazette and in a newspaper published or circulating in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia.
- 4. A certified copy of this By-law shall be filed in the Land Registry Office at the City of New Westminster, Province of British Columbia.
