

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 7441

A BY-LAW to amend By-Law No. 1914, being the
"Burnaby Automatic Vending Machine
By-Law 1946".

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby

ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY AUTOMATIC VENDING
MACHINE BY-LAW 1946, AMENDMENT BY-LAW 1979"

2. Section 8A(1) of By-Law No. 1914, as enacted by By-Law
No. 7303, is repealed and the following substituted therefor:

"8A (1) Every owner of an automatic vending machine or
every person who makes available, or who helps to make available,
for use or operation any automatic vending machine shall obtain a
licence therefor and shall pay the licence fee set out hereunder:

- (a) For each automatic vending machine for
the sale of confectionery when such
machine is operated by the insertion
of coins greater than one cent..... \$ 15.00
- (b) For each automatic vending machine for
the sale of stationery..... \$ 15.00
- (c) For each automatic vending machine for
the sale of tobacco, cigars or cigarettes \$ 15.00
- (d) For each automatic vending machine for
the sale of any other goods of any kind \$ 15.00
- (e) For each automatic vending machine for
the vending of amusements of any kind
when such machine is operated by the
insertion of coins greater than one
cent..... \$ 35.00
- (f) For each automatic vending machine for
the sale of confectionery where the said
machine is operated by the insertion of
one cent coins..... \$ 8.00
- (g) For each automatic vending machine for
the vending of amusements of any kind
operated by the insertion of one cent
coins..... \$ 8.00
- (h) For each postage stamp vending machine. \$ 8.00
- (i) For each coin operated radio receiver.. \$ 8.00 "

3. This by-law shall come into force on the 1st day of
January, 1980.
