## THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 7450

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A BY-LAW to acquire and dedicate certain lands for highway purposes.

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY ROAD ACQUISITION AND DEDICATION BY-LAW NO. 2, 1979".
- The Council is hereby authorized and empowered to acquire from the registered owner thereof by a good and sufficient deed in fee simple, free and clear of all encumbrances, for highway purposes, in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other good and valuable consideration, that portion of Lot "A", Block "B" of Block 1, District Lot 75, Group 1, Plan 4147 EXCEPT Part outlined red on Bylaw Plan 52301, New Westminster District, containing by admeasurement 0.0031 ha. shown outlined on plan annexed hereto prepared by Bryan S. Berting, B.C.L.S., sworn the 19th day of November, 1979.
- 3. Upon deposit of the said deed in fee simple in the Land
  Title Office at the City of New Westminster, Province of British Columbia,
  the lands therein described shall be established as a public highway.
