## THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 7458

A BY-LAW to Stop Up and Close to Traffic Portions of Road and Lane

WHEREAS those portions of road and lane shown on the plan annexed hereto dedicated by Plans 3045, 9148, 16871 and Plans with Filings 16627, 20422 and 61468 are no longer required for road purposes.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- ١. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY ROAD CLOSING BY-LAW NO. 9, 1979".
- 2. Those portions of road and lane situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, and being more particularly known and described as all those portions of road and lane in District Lot II, Group I, New Westminster District, dedicated by Plans 3045, 9148, 16871, and Plans with Filings 16627, 20422 and 61468, containing by admeasurement 0.1893 ha, 0.1565 ha, 0.2318 ha, 0.2011 ha, 0.0670 ha, 0.4999 ha, 0.0782 ha, 0.0782 ha and 0.1014 ha, shown on the Plan prepared by B. S. Berting, B.C.L.S., certified correct the 15th day of November, 1979, a copy of which is annexed hereto, are hereby stopped up and closed to traffic.
- 3. The Municipal Clerk is hereby authorized and empowered to petition the Minister of Municipal Affairs to abandon the said portions of road and lane more particularly described in Section 2 hereof and vest title thereto in the name of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby.
