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BY-LAW NO. 7509

A BY-LAW to adopt the annual budget of the Municipality for 1980.

WHEREAS on or before the fifteenth day of April in each year the Council shall cause to be prepared the annual budget for the current year.

AND WHEREAS the said budget has been prepared.

AND WHEREAS the said budget shall by by-law be adopted on or before the fifteenth day of May in each year.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY BUDGET AUTHORIZATION BY-LAW 1980".

2. The Council does hereby adopt and confirm the budget set out in Schedule "A" hereof as the annual budget of the Municipality for the year 1980.
