NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This BY-LAW may be cited as "BURNABY CAPITAL WORKS, MACHINERY AND EQUIPMENT RESERVE FUND EXPENDITURE BY-LAW 1980".
- 2. The sum of \$338,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the said

 Reserve Fund to be expended for the traffic control projects more particularly described in Schedule "A" annexed hereto.

3. Should any of the above amount remain unexpended after the expenditures hereby authorized have been made, any unexpended balance shall be returned to the credit of the said Reserve Fund.
