THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 7589

A BY-LAW to exempt from taxation certain lands within the Municipality.

WHEREAS Lot 1, Block 86 of District Lot 127, Group 1, Plan 4953, New Westminster District, but for a secondary use thereof and thereon would in the opinion of the Council be in conformity with the conditions necessary to qualify for tax exemption pursuant to clause (h) of section 398 of the Municipal Act, (hereinafter called "the said land").

AND WHEREAS such secondary use consists of the provisions of living quarters in part of the building situated upon the said property.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY TAXATION EXEMPTION BY-LAW NO. 5, 1980".
- 2. That for the year 1981 the said land and all improvements thereon shall be exempt save and except that portion of the improvements used for residential purposes.
