#### BY-LAW NO. 7606

A BY-LAW to amend By-Law No. 7509, being the "Burnaby Budget Authorization By-Law 1980".

- 2. Schedule "A" of By-Law No. 7509 is amended by striking out the figures in the columns entitled "1980 Annual" and replacing them respectively with the figures in the columns entitled "1980 Recast" in Schedule "A" hereunto annexed.
