THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY BY-LAW NO. 7619

A BY-LAW to acquire and dedicate certain lands for highway purposes

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This by-law may be cited as "BURNABY ROAD ACQUISITION AND DEDICATION BY-LAW NO. 2, 1980".
- 2. The Council is hereby authorized and empowered to acquire from the registered owner thereof by a good and sufficient transfer in fee simple, free and clear of all encumbrances, for highway purposes, in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other good and valuable consideration, those portions of Lots 10 and 11, Block 1, of the E½ of the E½ of Lot 70, Plan 1407, and a portion of the Part of Lot 73 shown marked Vancouver Fraser Valley and Southern Railway on Plan 3060, All of Group 1, New Westminster District, containing by admeasurement 0.0171 ha, 0.0095 ha, and 0.0161 ha respectively, shown outlined red on plan prepared by Ian C. MacDonald, B.C.L.S., sworn the 8th day of November, 1979.
- 3. Upon deposit of the said transfer in fee simple in the Land Title Office at the City of New Westminster, Province of British Columbia, the lands therein described shall be established as a public highway.
