## BY-LAW NO. 7620

## A BY-LAW to acquire and dedicate certain lands for highway purposes

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This by-law may be cited as "BURNABY ROAD ACQUISITION AND DEDICATION BY-LAW NO. 3, 1980".

2. The Council is hereby authorized and empowered to acquire from the registered owners thereof by a good and sufficient transfer in fee simple, free and clear of all encumbrances, for highway purposes, and for good and valuable consideration, those lands and premises situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, more particularly known and described as

- (a) that portion of Strata Plan NW 1300
  (of Parcel A , District Lot 97, Group 1, Plan 56839), New Westminster District, containing 1.125m<sup>2</sup>; and
- (b) that portion of Lot 12, Blocks 6A and 15A, District Lot 97, Group 1, Plan 1639, New Westminster District, containing 1.128m<sup>2</sup>;

as shown on Reference Plan prepared by Bryan S. Berting, B.C.L.S., dated October 23, 1980, deposited in the Land Title Office under Number \_\_\_\_\_\_, a copy of which is hereunto annexed.

3. Upon deposit of the said transfers in fee simple in the Land Title Office at New Westminster, Province of British Columbia, the lands therein described shall be established as a public highway.
