BY-LAW NO. 7649

A BY-LAW to adopt the capital expenditure program of the Municipality for the period 1981 to 1985.

- 1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY CAPITAL EXPENDITURE PROGRAM BY-LAW 1981".
- The Council does hereby adopt and confirm the capital 2. expenditure program set out in Schedule "A" annexed hereto as the capital expenditure program of the Municipality for the period 1981 to 1985 inclusive.
