BY-LAW NO. 7655

A BY-LAW to stop up and close to traffic
certain portions of road

WHEREAS those portions of road shown on the plan annexed hereto dedicated respectively by Plans 2278 and 10993 are no longer required for road purposes.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This by-law may be cited as "BURNABY ROAD CLOSING BY-LAW NO. 3, 1981".

2. Those portions of road situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, and being more particularly known and described as

(a) all that portion of District Lot 32, Group 1, New Westminster District, dedicated by Plan 2278, containing by admeasurement 1,043 m², shown outlined in heavy black line on plan annexed hereto, and

(b) all that portion of District Lot 32, Group 1, New Westminster District, dedicated by Plan 10993, containing by admeasurement 1,117 m², shown outlined in heavy black line and hatching on plan annexed hereto,

are hereby stopped up and closed to traffic.

3. The Municipal Clerk is hereby authorized and empowered to petition the Minister of Municipal Affairs to abandon the said portions of road more particularly described in section 2 hereof

and vest title thereto in the name of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby.
