BY-LAW NO. 7766

A BY-LAW to Stop Up and Close to Traffic a Portion of Road and Lane

WHEREAS that portion of road and lane shown on the plan annexed hereto dedicated by Plan 2855 is no longer required for road purposes.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

This by-law may be cited as "BURNABY ROAD CLOSING BY-LAW 1. NO. 8, 1981".

2. That portion of road and lane situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, and being more particularly known and described as that portion of road and lane in Block 4, District Lot 119, Group 1, New Westminster District, dedicated by Plan 2855 and containing by admeasurement 0.359 ha. shown outlined on the plan prepared by I. J. Royan, B.C.L.S., certified correct the 17th day of June, 1981, a copy of which is annexed hereto, is hereby stopped up and closed to traffic.

3. The Municipal Clerk is hereby authorized and empowered to petition the Minister of Municipal Affairs to abandon the said portion of road and lane more particularly described in section 2 hereof and vest title thereto in the name of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby.
