BY-LAW NO. 7792

A BY-LAW to permit persons to carry on all classes of retail business on a holiday pursuant to section 3 of the Holiday Shopping Regulation Act

WHEREAS the Council may, with the assent of the electors, adopt a by-law in respect of retail business, other than scheduled business, permitting a person

- (a) to carry on a certain class of retail business,
- (b) to sell or offer for sale a certain class of goods or service in a retail establishment, or
- (c) to admit the public to a retail establishment on a holiday or during the specified hours on a holiday.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This by-law may be cited as "BURNABY HOLIDAY SHOPPING REGULATION BY-LAW NO. 2, 1981".
- 2. Words or expressions used in this by-law shall, unless the context otherwise requires, have the same meaning as provided in the Holiday Shopping Regulation Act.
- Any person may, on a holiday and subject to any applicable bylaw of the Municipality, carry on all classes of retail business, sell or offer for sale all classes of goods or services in retail establishments, and admit the public thereto.
