## THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY BYLAW NO. 7832

A BYLAW to exempt from taxation certain lands within the Municipality pursuant to Section 398 (h) of the Municipal Act.

WHEREAS those lands occupied and held by BURNABY
UNIT OF JEHOVAH'S WITNESSES (5525 Short Street) and being
described as Lot 26, Block 1 of District Lot 98, Group 1,
Plan 1384, New Westminster District, but for a secondary use
thereof and thereon would in the opinion of the Council be in
conformity with the conditions necessary to qualify for tax
exemption pursuant to clause (h) of section 398 of the Municipal
Act, (hereinafter called "the said land").

AND WHEREAS such secondary use consists of the provisions of living quarters in part of the building situated upon the said property.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This Bylaw may be cited as "BURNABY TAXATION EXEMPTION BYLAW NO. 15, 1981".
- 2. That for the year 1982 the said land and all improvements thereon shall be exempt save and except that portion of the improvements used for residential purposes.
