

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BYLAW NO. 7862

A BYLAW to amend Bylaw No. 6191, being the  
"Burnaby Dog Tax and Pound and Animal  
Regulation Bylaw 1972"

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby  
ENACTS as follows:

1. This bylaw may be cited as "BURNABY DOG TAX AND POUND AND ANIMAL REGULATION BYLAW 1972, AMENDMENT BYLAW NO. 1, 1981".

2. Section 3 of Bylaw No. 6191 is repealed and the following substituted therefor:

"3. (1) Every person within the Municipality who owns a dog shall

(a) have a valid and subsisting licence for  
the said dog;

(b) procure the said licence upon application  
in writing to the Licence Inspector of the  
Corporation upon the form provided and upon  
paying the prescribed licence fee, namely:

(i) for each unneutered male dog.....\$ 25.00

(ii) for each neutered male dog.....\$ 10.00

(iii) for each unspayed female dog.....\$ 25.00

(iv) for each spayed female dog.....\$ 10.00

(2) Every person applying for a licence for a neutered male dog or spayed female dog shall, in order to obtain the said licence, present a certificate in writing from a licenced and qualified veterinarian certifying that the said dog is neutered or spayed.

(3) Upon presenting a certificate in writing from a licenced and qualified veterinarian certifying that a dog is too old or physically unable to undergo the necessary surgery, an applicant for a licence shall be entitled to obtain a licence for the said dog upon payment of the required fee for a spayed or neutered dog notwithstanding that the said dog is not spayed or neutered as the case may be.

(4) Every person who has obtained a licence for an unneutered male dog or unspayed female dog and paid therefor the fee specified herein shall, before the expiration of the licence period and within six months of the purchase of the licence, upon presenting a certificate in writing from a licenced and qualified veterinarian certifying that the dog for which the said licence was issued has been neutered or spayed, be entitled to a refund of \$15.00.

(5) The said licence when issued shall be for the current calendar year."

3. Clause (c) of section 5 is repealed and the following substituted therefor:

"(c) The penalty for a violation of clause (a) of section 5 shall be \$25.00 if the dog is licensed and \$40.00 plus licence fee if the dog is unlicensed."

4. Schedule "A" is amended by striking out items (1) and (2) and substituting therefor the following:

"(1)	For each licensed dog .....	\$ 25.00
(2)	For each unlicensed dog.....	\$ 40.00 plus licence fee"

5. Item (1) of Schedule "B" is repealed and the following substituted therefor:

"(1) For each dog..... \$ 3.00 per day  
or part of a day"

6. Item (4) of Schedule "C" is repealed and the following substituted therefor:

"(4) Notwithstanding anything in this Schedule contained, licensed veterinarians and other agencies approved by Council shall pay for the disposal of animals and poultry \$ .15 per pound

7. This bylaw shall come into force and effect on the 1st day of January, 1982.

Read a third time this 30th day of NOVEMBER 1981.

Reconsidered and adopted this 14th day of DECEMBER 1981.
