## THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

## BYLAW NO. 7906

A BYLAW to acquire and dedicate certain lands for highway purposes

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This bylaw may be cited as "BURNABY ROAD ACQUISITION AND DEDICATION BYLAW NO. 1, 1982".
- 2. The Council is hereby authorized and empowered to acquire from the registered owners thereof by a good and sufficient transfer in fee simple, free and clear of all encumbrances, for highway purposes, and for good and valuable consideration, those lands and premises situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, more particularly known and described as those portions of Lots 3, 4 and 5, Block 49, of District Lot 69, Group 1, Plan 1321, New Westminster District, shown outlined in red on plan prepared by Bryan S. Berting, B.C.L.S., deposited in the Land Title Office under Number \_\_\_\_\_\_\_\_, a copy of which is hereunto annexed, the said portion of the said Lot 3 containing 46.9 m<sup>2</sup>, the said portion of the said Lot 4 containing 108.7 m<sup>2</sup> and the said portion of the said Lot 5 containing 154.3 m<sup>2</sup>.
- 3. Upon deposit of the said transfer in fee simple in the Land Title Office at New Westminster, Province of British Columbia, the lands therein described shall be established as a public highway.
