BYLAW NO. 7923

A BYLAW to dispose of certain portions of highway in exchange for other land

WHEREAS pursuant to section 574 of the Municipal Act R.S.B.C. 1979 the Council may by bylaw dispose of any portion of a highway in exchange for such lands as may be necessary for the purpose of improving, widening, straightening, relocating or diverting a highway.

AND WHEREAS all deeds executed under this section have effect as a Crown grant, free of all rights of way, and all lands taken in exchange for any portion of a highway under this section are public highways, and the title thereto is vested in the Crown.

AND WHEREAS the Council, before adopting this bylaw, has caused the required statutory public notice of its intention to be given by advertisement.

AND WHEREAS the Council deems it expedient and in the public interest to stop up and close to traffic those portions of highway more particularly hereinafter described for the purpose of relocating and diverting a highway.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This bylaw may be cited as "BURNABY HIGHWAY EXCHANGE BYLAW NO. 2, 1982".

2. The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is hereby authorized and empowered to stop up and close to traffic ALL AND SINGULAR that certain parcel or tract of land and premises situate, lying and being in the Municipality of ġ)

Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, more particularly known and described as those portions of road in District Lot 6, Group 1, Plan 26211 and Plan 58622 having areas of 223.0 m^2 , 177.0 m^2 and 0.2848 ha respectively, shown cross-hatched on plan annexed hereto prepared by Ian C. MacDonald, B.C.L.S., certified correct the 8th day of April, 1982 (hereinafter called "the said closed portions of road").

3. The Council is further authorized and empowered to grant and convey the said closed portions of road unto the registered owner of Lot 7, Block 24, District Lot 6, Group 1, Plan 4155, New Westminster District (hereinafter called "the said land") in exchange for that portion of the said land shown in heavy outline on the said plan annexed hereto prepared by Ian C. MacDonald, B.C.L.S., having an area of 154.1 m² and that portion of the said land shall, upon deposit of the necessary transfer in the Land Title Office, be a public highway and title thereto shall be vested in the Crown.
