THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BYLAW NO. 7949

A BYLAW to dispose of a certain portion of highway in exchange for other land

WHEREAS pursuant to section 574 of the Municipal Act R.S.B.C. 1979 the Council may by bylaw dispose of any portion of a highway in exchange for such lands as may be necessary for the purpose of improving, widening, straightening, relocating or diverting a highway.

AND WHEREAS all deeds executed under this section have effect as a Crown grant, free of all rights of way, and all lands taken in exchange for any portion of a highway under this section are public highways, and the title thereto is vested in the Crown.

AND WHEREAS the Council, before adopting this bylaw, has caused the required statutory public notice of its intention to be given by advertisement.

AND WHEREAS the Council deems it expedient and in the public interest to stop up and close to traffic that portion of highway more particularly hereinafter described for the purpose of relocating and diverting a highway.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This bylaw may be cited as "BURNABY HIGHWAY EXCHANGE BYLAW NO. 3, 1982".
- 2. The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is hereby authorized and empowered to stop up and close to traffic ALL AND SINGULAR that certain parcel or tract of land and premises, situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, more particularly known and

described as all that portion of road in District Lot 30, Group 1, New Westminster District, shown on Plan 3036, containing 0.0353 ha (hereinafter called "the said closed portion of road") and shown hatched within the heavy black outline on Reference Plan prepared by J. G. Cameron, B.C.L.S., deposited in the Land Title Office under Number _____, a copy of which is hereunto annexed (hereinafter called "the said plan").

3. The Council is further authorized and empowered to grant and convey the said closed portion of road unto the registered owner of Parcel "A" (Explanatory Plan 929) of Lot 3, Plan 301 and Lot 8, Blocks 1 and 3, Plan 556, both of District Lot 95, Group 1, New Westminster District (hereinafter called "the said Parcel "A" and Lot 8") in exchange for those portions of the said Parcel "A" and Lot 8 containing respectively 0.0330 ha and 0.0439 ha shown within the heavy black outline on the said plan, and those portions of the said Parcel "A" and Lot 8 shall, upon deposit of the necessary transfer in the Land Title Office, be a public highway and title thereto shall be vested in the Crown.
