BYLAW NO. 7969

A BYLAW to Stop Up and Close to Traffic a Portion of Road

WHEREAS that portion of road shown on the plan annexed hereto dedicated by Plan 1256 is no longer required for road purposes.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This bylaw may be cited as "BURNABY ROAD CLOSING BYLAW NO. 4, 1982".
- That portion of road situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, and being more particularly known and described as that portion of road in District Lot 138, Group 1, New Westminster District, dedicated by Plan 1256, containing by admeasurement 0.1849 ha shown outlined on the plan prepared by Bryan S. Berting, B.C.L.S., certified correct the 7th day of September, 1982, a copy of which is annexed hereto, is hereby stopped up and closed to traffic.
- The Municipal Clerk is hereby authorized and empowered 3. to petition the Minister of Municipal Affairs to abandon the said portion of road more particularly described in section 2 hereof and vest title thereto in the name of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby.
